Dear Parents of Middle School:

Below is a list of materials that every Middle School student will need this year. **Teachers may ask for additional supplies throughout the year.** All supplies should be replenished throughout the year. Students who are not prepared may receive an F on any assignments for that day. No borrowing supplies from other students!

- 1 small package of pens (red or green)
- 1 small package of pens (blue or black)
- 1 small package of pencils (wood or mechanical) Suggested brand: Dixon Ticonderoga
- 1 small package of highlighters
- 1 portfolio with at least 5 sections OR 5 folders
- 1 12-inch ruler with centimeter markings
- 2 pack of graph paper
- Binder paper
- Small stapler with staples
- 2 glue sticks and 1 small liquid glue
- Small pair of scissors
- Package of large, black dry erase markers (at least 4)
- Felt-tip markers NO SHARPIES / PERMANENT INK!!!
- Colored pencils for Math
